



Additional Information to know



- The cost to play is \$600 (4th-8th)
- Cost includes Uniform, shooting shirt, insurance, practice (60-90 minutes twice per week), games, and of course everlasting memories! Younger group gets some practice time through the PRC.
- Optional- we will have additional items that are optional such a backpacks, practice jerseys and gear for families.
- Games- Teams will play in a select league and participate in two tournaments OR do 5 tournaments. We leave this up to the coach's discretion to do what they feel is best for their team.
- Tournament- We will also host our own boy's tournament (November 14th and 15th) and girls' tournament (December 19th-20th). So, teams will essentially do 3 or 6 tournaments if you include this one. This is a program fundraiser so we will ask parents to help by volunteering (this also gets you in for free)
- There is a multiple player discount of \$50 dollars off the individual cost for each additional child.
- Payments will be broken into 2 chunks (\$300 each). You will receive invoices. The first invoice will be sent out mid-October (we need this to get uniforms ordered). The 2nd invoice will be sent out the end of November/Beginning of December. Please note failures to pay or communicate could result in your athlete being asked to leave the program.
- Please understand some items/fees are not refundable if your athlete chooses to stop being a part of Puyallup Elite.
- Feeder team practices and games will run November- End of February/Beginning of March
- Practice times will be approximately 60 or 90 minutes twice a week for younger and older groups respectively at Puyallup School District Facilities (we don't get a choice in facilities).
- If your team is motivated to attend more tournaments, we encourage you to do so. This will be at additional team costs to be communicated and collected by your coach.

If Your Athlete Makes a Team

- If your athlete makes the team you will see their name posted by Wednesday, October 1st on www.vikinghoops.org and receive an email from your coach. **Your coach will be asking you to accept or decline by filling out a survey by midnight Friday October 2nd .** Your coach will also provide directions on how to get your gear ordered.
